Within the framework of support to local projects of the Embassy of Japan, the ceremony marking the signature of the Grant Contract between the Embassy of Japan and GIC FADESE (Groupe d'Initiative Commune des Femmes Actives pour le Développement Economique et Social) took place at the Embassy of Japan in Yaoundé, on Friday, 29<sup>th</sup> January 2016 at 11am, in the presence of the Ambassador of Japan, H.E.
