Within the framework of grant assistance for grassroots human security projects of the Embassy of Japan, the ceremony marking the project « Reinforcement of technical capacities of Cameroon Pasteur Center by the acquisition of an open and efficient system for multiplex analysis in Immunology », was held on Wednesday 18th July 2018 at Centre Pasteur du Cameroun (CPC), in the presence of the Ambassador of Japan, Mr. Kunio Okamura, Secretary of State to the MINSANTE, Mr. Alim Hayatou, the representative of Ambassador of France, and Pr. Joseph Mbede, Chairman of the Board of Cameroon Pasteur Center.
