Within the framework of grant assistance for grassroots human security projects of the Embassy of Japan, the ceremony marking the « Project for Construction and Equipement of a modern maternity room in the Ngovayang Hospital », was held on Wednesday 20th July 2018 at Lolodorf, in the South Region of Cameroon, in the presence of the Ambassador of Japan, Mr. Kunio Okamura, the Secretary General of Ministry of Social Affairs, and Ms. Miwou Woungly Massaga, Mayor of Lolodorf.

The grant of about 31 million FCFA, signed on the 2nd February 2018 enabled the “Fondation pour l’Environnement et le Développement (FEDEC)” to acquire a modern maternity room of advanced materials, for the best care of mothers and children in Lolodorf.

Through this project, the Government of Japan aims to support Cameroonian people to live in good health, and promote the well-being of all at all ages.
