

JAPANESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2020

THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, CULTURE, SPORTS, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (MONBUKAGAKUSHO: MEXT) OFFERS SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDIES IN JAPAN.

Three (03) types of study and research scholarships are available for Cameroonian students.

- 1. Required qualifications (for more details, see the website below.)
 - A) Research program
 - ✓ Born on or after April 2, 1985
 - ✓ Have completed 16 years of schooling since elementary school or a degree holder before leaving for Japan (April or October 2020). (For applicants wishing to study medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, or veterinary medicine, conditions are different. See the website below.).
 - B) Undergraduate program
 - ✓ Born on or after April 2, 1995.
 - ✓ Have completed 12 years of schooling since elementary school or degree holder before leaving for Japan (April 2020)
 - C) College of Technology program
 - ✓ Born on or after April 2, 1995.
 - ✓ Have completed 11 years of schooling since elementary school or degree holder before leaving for Japan (April 2020)

Applicants must be proficient in English and have the desire to learn the Japanese language.
