

## **JAPANESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2020**

THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, CULTURE, SPORTS, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (MONBUKAGAKUSHO: MEXT) OFFERS SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDIES IN JAPAN.

Three (03) types of study and research scholarships are available for Cameroonian students.

- 1. Required qualifications (for more details, see the website below.)
  - A) Research program
    - ✓ Born on or after April 2, 1985
    - ✓ Have completed 16 years of schooling since elementary school or a degree holder before leaving for Japan (April or October 2020). (For applicants wishing to study medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, or veterinary medicine, conditions are different. See the website below. ).
  - B) Undergraduate program
    - ✓ Born on or after April 2, 1995.
    - ✓ Have completed 12 years of schooling since elementary school or degree holder before leaving for Japan (April 2020)
  - C) College of Technology program
    - ✓ Born on or after April 2, 1995.
    - ✓ Have completed 11 years of schooling since elementary school or degree holder before leaving for Japan (April 2020)

## Applicants must be proficient in English and have the desire to learn the Japanese language.
