COMMUNIQUE DE PRESSE

Le lundi 25 avril 2022, en présence du Secrétaire Général du Ministère de l'Education Nationale, M. OYONO Adams Daniel et du Nonce Apostolique au Cameroun, S.E.Mgr Julio MURAT, s'est tenue à la résidence de l'Ambassadeur du Japon en République du Cameroun, S.E.M. TAKAOKA Nozomu, la cérémonie de remise des lettres d'achèvement en faveur du "*Catholic Education Secretariat/Diocese of Buea*" et "*The Lighthouse Association*".

Le financement de ces projets respectivement intitulés "The Project for Construction of St. Laetitia Catholic Nursery and Primary School in Southwest Region" et "The Project for Construction of storey building for MOUNT ZION Nursery and Primary School in Southwest Region" est une autre réussite du programme d'aide aux projets locaux contribuant à la sécurité humaine (KUSANONE). KUSANONE a débuté au Cameroun en 1993 et a bénéficié depuis lors, à de nombreuses communautés de ce pays.

Catholic Education Secretariat/Diocese of Buea et The Lighthouse Association ont respectivement reçu un financement d'environ cinquante millions de francs CFA pour construire de nouvelles salles de classe, de nouveaux bureaux et de nouvelles toilettes pour accueillir des centaines d'élèves, y compris ceux issus de familles déplacées.

Il est à espérer que ces projets d'intérêt éducatif renforcera davantage l'amitié entre le Japon et le Cameroun.

On Monday, April 25, 2022, in the presence of the Secretary General of the Ministry of Basic Education, Mr.OYONO Adams Daniel and the Nuncio Apostolic, H.E. Mgr Julio MURAT, the handing over ceremony of completion letters in favour of the Catholic Education Secretariat/Diocese of Buea and The Lighthouse Association was held at the residence of the Japanese Ambassador H.E. TAKAOKA Nozomu.

The grant of these projects entitled "The Project for Construction of St. Laetitia Catholic Nursery and Primary School in Southwest Region" and "The Project for Construction of storey building for MOUNT ZION Nursery and Primary School in Southwest Region" is yet another success story of the Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects (KUSANONE). KUSANONE started in Cameroon in 1993 and has benefited many communities in this country since then.

Catholic Education Secretariat/Diocese of Buea and The Lighthouse Association respectively has received approximately fifty million CFA francs grant to build new classrooms, new offices and new toilets accommodating hundreds of pupils including those from displaced families.

It is hoped that these educative projects will further strengthen friendship between Japan and Cameroon.
